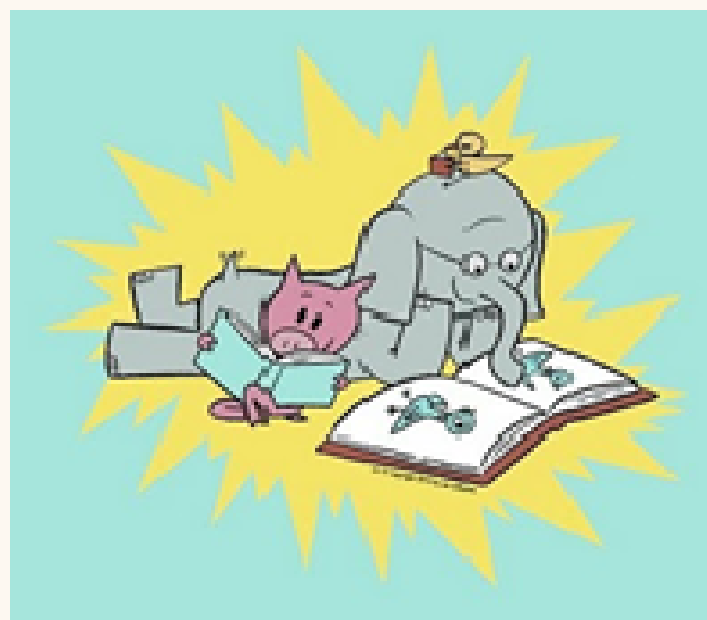

## HOW TO GET A LIBRARY CARD

To get a free library card:

- You must live within the boundaries of the Library District.
- You must present a Drivers License or State ID with your name, address and picture.
- You must present proof of residency. \*If your ID has your current Sauk Village address you will need 1 piece of mail or rent/mortgage documents to prove residency. \*If your ID has a different address you will need to provide 3 pieces of mail or rent/mortgage documents.

Out of district patrons will need to pay \$85.00 dollars to receive a library card.

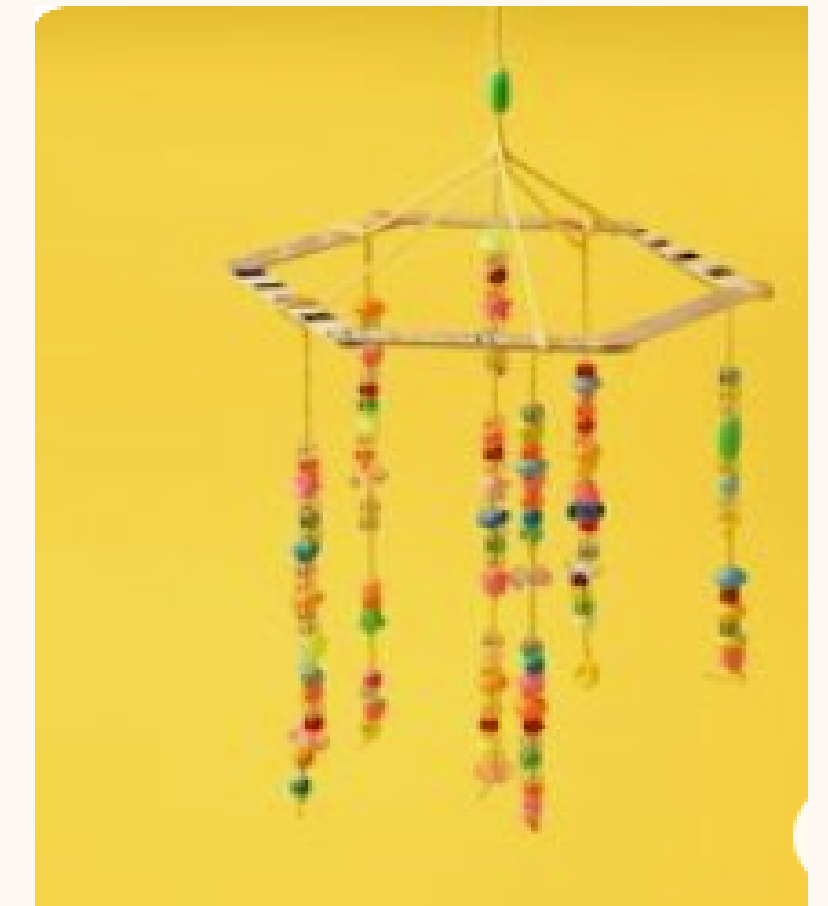

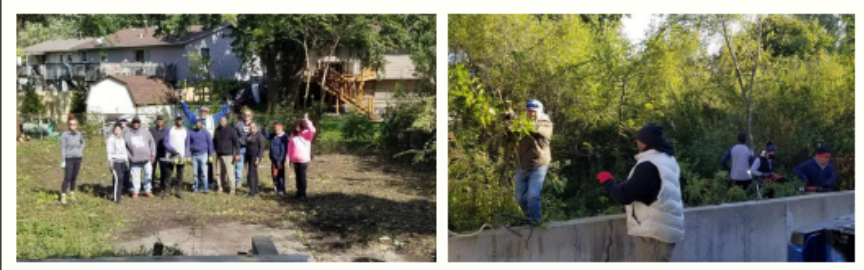
